

Water Softener Installation in Central Florida

Central Florida sits on limestone, so most homes here run 10–20 grains per gallon of hardness. A softener swaps those calcium and magnesium ions out before the water reaches your pipes, so scale stops building inside your water heater, fixtures and appliances.

Signs you need this

- White crust on faucets, shower heads and glass doors
- Soap and shampoo that never lather well
- Skin that feels tight and laundry that feels stiff
- Water heater running louder or costing more each year
- Spots on dishes straight out of the dishwasher

How it works

1. Free in-home hardness test

We measure grains per gallon, iron and chlorine at your kitchen tap and hand you written results before recommending any equipment.

2. Right-sized ion exchange

Grain capacity is matched to your hardness and household size so the system regenerates on demand instead of on a wasteful timer.

3. Licensed installation

Installed at the main line with a bypass valve, drain and proper permitting - usually a single half-day appointment.

What you get

- Longer life from water heaters, dishwashers and washing machines
- Up to 50% less soap and detergent
- No more scale rings in sinks and toilets
- Softer skin, hair and laundry

Frequently asked questions

How hard is Orlando water?

Most Central Florida supplies test between 10 and 20 grains per gallon - well above the 7 gpg where scale problems start. Well water in outlying areas often tests higher and adds iron.

Will softened water taste salty?

No. Ion exchange leaves a very small amount of sodium - far less than a slice of bread per glass. If you want zero added sodium at the tap, we pair the softener with reverse osmosis at the kitchen sink.

How much salt will I use?

A typical Central Florida family of four uses one to two 40 lb bags a month. Demand-initiated regeneration keeps that as low as your actual water use allows.
